We can't move it ourselves. It's too heavy.

We'll have to try. We'll put the rug under it.

Good idea. Then we'll slide it into the other room



NEW EXPRESSIONS!

The moving company just called.

A description of something that happened recently.

They **just told** me about the meeting.

It **just happened** two minutes ago.

We'll have to

Describes something that has to happen in the future, using the contracted form of the modal verb “will”.

I'll **talk** to you later today.

She'll **cook** dinner for us tonight.

We can't

The modal verb “can” in its negative contracted form. “Can” indicates the ability or the possibility of doing something.

She **can't** go out today, she's grounded.

I **can not** believe you lied to them.

Too heavy

An adjective coupled with “too”, a word that in this case, has a negative connotation. “Too” is a sentence modifier, which means that it can alter the meaning of a sentence.

This is **too good** to be true.

She is **too small** to ride the rollercoaster.
