“It rained on our vacation, but **all in all** we had a great time”

“**All in All**, I'm glad I visited New York City.”



TO BREAK THE ICE

To do something to eliminate shyness, awkward situations or unfamiliarity.

“I was so nervous, but my friend immediately **broke the ice!**”

“I tried **breaking the ice** with a joke, but it didn't help”

WALLFLOWER

Someone with an introvert personality type. It is someone who will usually limit themselves to standing away from the crowd and simply acting as an onlooker.

“She spent the whole night being a **wallflower**”

“I was always a **wallflower** in high school”

BALL ROLLING

To start something, to set something.

“I just want enough cash to start the **ball rolling**”

“The teacher asked a few questions to start the **ball rolling**”.



TO GO OUT OF ONE'S WAY

To inconvenience one's self in doing something beyond what is required. To do something more than necessary.

“You didn't have **to go out of your way** to help me”

“She seems **to go out of her way** all the time!”
