She's such a nice girl.

This is such a good present for Christmas.

### *Comparatives short adjectives*

She is busier than you.

### *Buy for*

I want to buy a gift for my mom.

I want to buy my mom a gift.

He bought a car for his father.

He bought his father a car.



### *Comparatives long adjectives*

My car is more expensive than yours.

This meeting is more important than the party.
