# WHEN I WAS A KID

## DIALOGUE

Girl: I was never good at hula hooping.

Boy: What else did you do when you were a kid?

Girl: I loved drawing and playing hopscotch.

Boy: Were you any good at drawing?

Girl: My parents used to say I was like Picasso!



# NEW EXPRESSIONS!

## It was my favorite when I was a kid

It's a structure in the past indicating what someone liked to do the most when they were kids, children.

I wasn't much of an athlete. I liked reading. It was my favorite when I was a kid.

Oh, you made pasta with hot dogs! It was my favorite when I was a kid.

## I used to love

"Used to" is an expression we use to talk about something that happened often in the past, but doesn't now. In this case, it's paired with "love", but it can be used with many other verbs.

I used to read all night long, even after my mom sent me to bed.

She used to swim in the lake.

I used to love playing with dolls.

## I would play

An expression used in this context to imply that, if it was possible, that was something the person would always do, nonstop. Also used with other verbs.

I would eat the whole pot of brigadeiro.

She would stay out all night.



## What else did you do when you were a kid?

In the way that it's structured, a way to ask more information about activities done when the person was a child. The beginning and end of that question can be switched to fit most situations.

**What else did you do that afternoon?**

**Did you play cards when you were a kid?**

**Were you any good at drawing?**

A question using the past form of verb be.

**Were you any good at swimming?**

**Was she late for the meeting?**
