An expression that means to regain control of one's emotions. To get control of emotions or actions after being upset; to calm oneself down.

She was angry with him, but she managed to pull herself together before talking to him.

I need to pull myself together if I'm to finish this task by tomorrow.

Big deal

Words that describe something considered important, a thing, or a person.

I didn't know he was such a big deal.

She tries not to make a big deal out of small problems.

See eye to eye

An idiom that means to have similar views or attitudes to something; be in full agreement.

They don't see eye to eye on the contract.

I'm glad we see eye to eye on this.
