NEW EXPRESSIONS!

Will

A modal verb used to express the future tense and/or inevitable events.

Will she go out with us?

Will you help me?

If

A conjunction that introduces a conditional clause. It means “on the condition or supposition that”, “in the event that”.

Call me **if** you need anything.

If you have any trouble, have them call me, please.

Pinky promise/Pinky swear

A traditional gesture most commonly practiced among children involving the locking of the pinkies of two people to signify that a promise has been made. The gesture is taken to signify that the person can break the finger of the one who broke the promise.

We have to go, we **pinky promised**.

I **pinky swear** I will not eat your cake.



Coming right up

Used by someone to say that something will be served or delivered very quickly.

Your lemonade is **coming right up**.

My wings should be **coming right up**.
